Cleaning Campaign by the members of NVSS

Date: 22-23 December, 2007
Venue: Way to Paro Taktsang and beyond

A total of 22 members of the a societal group called Nopkin Volunteers for Social Services (NVSS) clean swept the way to Paro Taktsang and beyond till the monastery called Zangtopelri, a half an hour or so walk from Taktsang and collected about 20 sacks of garbage.

NVSS is a volunteers group formed by the members of the weblog called Nopkin.com (www.nopkin.com) with the objective to create awareness to the people on the importance of keeping the surroundings clean and also to render other public services.

Besides cleaning the way to the monastery, the members also cleaned the areas around the monastery called Zimchungtshabu, a half an hour or so walk from Taktsang and Zangtopelri, about 10 minutes' walk still fuether up, where there were garbages spread around in gay abandon below the monasteries.
